

# THIS WEEK IN BEER

## Draught Beers

**Cape Ann Pumpkin Stout**-(Massachusetts)- 6.75% ABV- 2007 New England Microbrew Champ and Silver Medal winner at the 2007 Great International Beer Festival! This very unique style is more stout than the usual "pumpkin pie" ales that are out there, with hints of real pumpkin & spice and a dark, coffee, stout flavor! \$-5

**Dogfish Head 60 Minute IPA** (Rehoboth Beach, Delaware) - 6.00% ABV- India Pale Ale- Dogfish Head's flagship beer brewed with warrior, Amarillo, and mystery hop X. A powerful east coast IPA with a citrusy hop character. \$-5

**Duvel Green**- (Belgium) – 6.80% ABV- A single fermentation beer brewed with the finest malts and two top quality hops: Saaz-Saaz and stryian golding. The first fermentation and lagering creates the unique and typical Duvel taste. \$ - 7

**Evolution Primal Pale Ale**-(Delmar, Delaware) – 4.9% ABV- A golden, dry, hoppy pale ale. Refreshing and balanced. Notes of pine and citrus. \$-4.50

**Gordon Biersch Festbier**-(California)- 5.4% ABV-Gordon Biersch FestBier celebrates fall and the flavor profile of beers served at the modern-day Oktoberfest. FestBier emphasizes rich, malty undertones with a moderately hoppy finish.. \$-5

**Guinness** (Ireland) - 4.20% ABV- Enough said. \$-6

**Lagunitas New Dog town Ale**- (California) - 6.40% ABV – An American Pale Ale brewed with citrus hops. A clean, crisp pale ale with a hoppy finish. \$-5

**Mama's Little Yellow Pils**- (Colorado) – 5.3% ABV- small-batch version of the beer that made Pilsen, Czechoslovakia famous. Mama's is made with hearty amounts of pale malt, German specialty malts, and traditional (Saaz) and 21st century Bavarian hops. It's the perfect antidote for the watered-down, cornfed versions of pilsner clogging America's shelves. \$ 4.50

**Ommegang Hennepin**- (New York) - - 7.7% ABV- This classic saison style Belgian ale, has apple and citrus flavors, with a spicy finish. One of Ommegang's most popular beers. \$-5-

**Ommegang Witte**- (New York)-5.10% ABV- Witte is brewed with malted and unmalted wheat, barley malt, a light hops addition and spiced with sweet orange peel and coriander. Though adding a slice of citrus fruit is common while enjoying a wheat or Wiess beer.. \$-5

**Pyramid Hefeweizen** (Seattle, Washington) - 5.2% ABV- Pyramid hefeweizen is an American take on a Bavarian classic, which is unfiltered for a very flavorful yet remarkably refreshing taste. This beer has won more awards than any other beer in its class. \$-4.50

**Southern Tier Raspberry Wheat**- (New York)- 4.60% ABV- A golden wheat beer brewed with the finest North American malted barley and wheat. It's then lightly hopped with the choicest European varieties. This smooth, crisp golden wheat beer is then finished with a hint of raspberry. Enjoy this beer any time of year. \$4.50

**Warsteiner Oktoberfest**- (Germany) - 5.9% ABV- Premium Oktoberfest is amber in color and provides a full bodied flavor that combines a nice balance of hops and rich maltiness. \$-5

**Weyerbacher Autumnfest ale**– (Pennsylvania) – 5.4%- ABV –AutumnFest is Weyerbacher's own unique twist on the German Oktoberfest style. Copper-amber in color, AutumnFest is made with Vienna and Munich malts for that authentic, Bavarian easy drinking taste\$-5
